## Directions

- 1. Go to www.gapminder.org
- 2. Click on the Gapminder World tab at the top.
- 3. Begin with the x-axis set to Income per person and the y-axis set to life expectancy.
- 4. Begin with the timeline set on 2010, or the most recent year available.
- 5. Use the select function on the right hand side to highlight the countries we are trying to find.
- 6. Record the information in the appropriate spaces of the data sets on the *Inequality Inquisition* graphic organizer.
- 7. Now you are going to manipulate the x and y- axes in order to look at the other variables; you may manipulate both axes at the same time or not.
