

## The “Haves” and the “Have-Nots”: A Look at Inequality in the World Today

### Directions

1. Go to [www.gapminder.org](http://www.gapminder.org)
2. Click on the Gapminder World tab at the top.
3. Begin with the x-axis set to Income per person and the y-axis set to life expectancy.
4. Begin with the timeline set on 2010, or the most recent year available.
5. Use the select function on the right hand side to highlight the countries we are trying to find.
6. Record the information in the appropriate spaces of the data sets on the *Inequality Inquisition* graphic organizer.
7. Now you are going to manipulate the x – and y- axes in order to look at the other variables; you may manipulate both axes at the same time or not.
8. Always look at the most current year available.
9. Look at the following variables to complete the graphic organizer.
  - a. Child mortality
  - b. Literacy rate, adult total
  - c. Human Development Index
10. If you have trouble finding any of the variables, please ask me for assistance.
11. Complete the Observations sheet.
12. After completing all the steps above, choose four countries you would like to examine as a group and write them below. Choose two countries you believe are considered developed and two you believe are considered developing.
