You are ready to finalize your commitment to the 2023-24 cohort of Kenan Fellows. Please follow the steps below and plan for an exciting year of change and growth.

Go to kenanfellowsofncsu.org/welcome to download your acceptance packet. Once you have downloaded the acceptance packet and signed all of the necessary forms, visit tinyurl.com/23-KFP-New-Fellows to complete the intake form and upload your signed documents.

You will receive a separate email for completing an *IRS W-9 Form* and a *Vendor Enrollment Form* via Payment Works to process your stipend payments.

Statement of Commitment

The Kenan Fellows Program for Teacher Leadership at NC State supports outstanding teachers in developing instructional and leadership skills that benefit their careers, their students, and advances the teaching profession. The project can be a lesson plan or unit, a community engagement plan, a product for your mentor organization or a teacher training session. Please note that certain fellowship projects may require a specific product.

Stipend Information and Schedule of Payments

Stipend Stipulations

Kenan Fellows will receive a stipend for their professional time and development of a fellowship product. Stipend payments are contingent upon completion of program benchmarks. You will receive \$3,000 at the start of the fellowship (June) and the remaining \$2,000 at the conclusion of the fellowship year (May).

Attendance

Kenan Fellows are required to attend the internship, Summer, Fall, Spring Institutes, and to deliver a final product to receive full stipend payment. You will be asked to sign in and out each day of the institutes. If you must miss or leave early from any portion of the institutes for any reason, your May 2024 stipend payment will be adjusted to reflect your absence at a rate of \$30 for each hour missed. We plan and in many cases pay for all aspects of the institutes in advance and need to ensure that no investment is lost. Each Fellow is responsible for arranging substitute pay with their school and/or district. **Invoices sent to the Kenan Fellows Program will not be processed.**

LIABILITY WAIVER, ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration for being allowed by NC State to participate in the Kenan Fellows Program and its related activities, (including educational and recreational activities), (collectively hereinafter "Program") the undersigned hereby agrees as follows:

I do hereby affirm and acknowledge that I am participating in the Program for my own personal benefit, and have been fully informed of the inherent and potential hazards and risks to me associated with participation in the Program and any physical exertion required therein. I understand and acknowledge that the inherent dangers and physical risks involved in the Program are such that no amount of care, caution, instruction or expertise can eliminate. These dangers and risks include, but are not limited to, loss or damage of personal property, broken bones, strains, sprains, bruises, heart attacks, heat exhaustion, concussions, and other personal injuries, or even death, that could result from tripping, falling, contact with other individuals, exposure to temperature extremes or inclement weather, sun hazards, equipment failure, and vehicle accidents while traveling to and from the Program's sites. I assume responsibility for all risks, known and unknown, involved to me and my property in the aforementioned activities, and I am voluntarily participating in reliance upon my own judgment and knowledge of my experience and capabilities.
