Skills to develop and maintain meaningful connections with local business and industry leaders



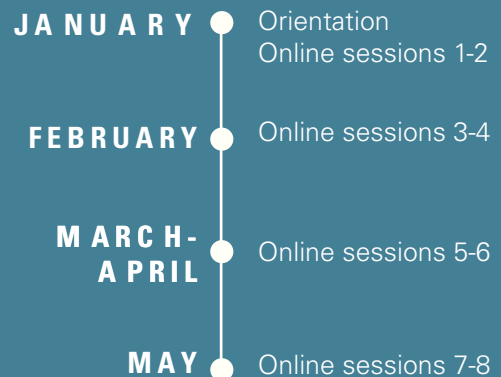
Trained facilitator who will provide feedback throughout the course
